Themes

Indian Music

- Senior Solo ~ Light Classical/ Ghazal / Thumri – 3 prizes
- Senior Duet ~ Contemporary / Bollywood – 3 sets of prizes
- Senior Group ~ Sufi / Traditional – 2 sets of prizes
- Junior Solo ~ Folk / Non Filmy – 3 prizes
- Junior Group ~ Retro – 2 sets of prizes

In **Western Music** you are free to choose any theme.

In the **Informal's**, there will be surprise announcements from time to time and students of any school can participate if they have a valid Identity Card. Gifts will be given to the winners along with certificates. Ordinarily, the singers taking part in this event should not be a part of the Registered Team of the participating school.

In **Rock Band** you are free to choose any music, Indian or Western. Total performance should not exceed 15 minutes, including sound check time. Maximum number of participants from a school is 8. Please bring your own instruments. Only a drum set will be provided.

The Rules

- Participating schools are expected to send in 1 soloist, 8 to 15 students in the Group, 2 in the Duet and 3 in the Trio event in each of the 4 categories (Western Juniors (no Trio), Western Seniors, Indian Juniors (no Duet), Indian Seniors). Any bonafide student of a participating school can take part in the Informal's. Each School is expected to perform in Rock Band, if they have taken part in at least 3 events on the first two days.
- A student participating in Western Music can take part in Indian Music and the Rock Band as well, though different students will be appreciated.
- Maximum number of accompaniments allowed is three.
- The minimum number of participants in the Group is 8 and maximum 15.
- Trio is only for Western Music Seniors. Duets are only for Indian Music Seniors.
- The total time given for a single performance is 5 minutes, including sound check.
- Recorded music (Karaoke) **is allowed**. Auto rhythm is of course permitted.
- Participants **should not** turn up in their School Uniforms.
- Students are expected to carry their Identity Cards at all times.

There will be stalls where food and water will be available at a cost. Lunch will be provided to the participants.

- An act of grave indiscipline may disqualify the team from the contest.
- School teams must be accompanied by at least two teachers from their respective schools.
- The decision of the Judges will be final and no protests will be entertained thereafter.
- Please spell the names of the participants correctly in the Entry Forms as they will appear on the certificates.
- The last date for the submission of Entries is **30 September, 2016**.
